

**Milwaukee Chapter Impaired Rider Policy**

The purpose of this document is to establish guidance to the Milwaukee H.O.G Chapter in regards to impairment in conjunction with Chapter Ride functions. Consistent application of this procedure will assure safety of all members and participants during any designated Chapter ride event.

**The Milwaukee H.O.G. Chapter has a “ZERO Tolerance” policy.**

There will be no tolerance for any member or participant attending a Milwaukee Chapter ride function who has been impaired by either drugs (legal or illegal) or alcohol either “**before**” a Chapter ride or “**during**” a Chapter ride.

In the event that any person(s) attending a Milwaukee Chapter ride whether open or closed, who has been determined to be impaired will be asked not to ride with the group.

Once the ride is determined to be “over”, usually when the destination is reached, an announcement will be made that the ride is complete. Members then are on their own and no longer considered the responsibility of the Chapter,
